課題1 Interview Project(単位認定を申請する人は必須)

Choose one person that you meet while you are studying abroad that you think is an interesting person. You could choose a member of your host family, another student studying at the same university (either a foreign student or a regular student) or one of your teachers. Ask that person if they would allow you to interview them for your project. You want to try to find out as much as possible about that person during the interview. You can use the following questions as a guideline for your interview, or you can ask ones that you think of on your own. Take notes during your interview so you won't forget important information. You might also want to take some pictures of your interviewee at the same time. After your interview you will write a three to seven page report on that person. It sounds like a lot, but you may also use pictures, drawing, and other visual aids in your report. But your report should be between 1000-2000 words. This is a chance for you to be very creative! Submit your report in a file folder. Your report will be returned to you and it will become one of your memories of your study abroad.

Example Interview Questions

- note: some questions may not be appropriate...for example, you should never ask how much money a person has, you should not ask how old a person is (but they may tell you how old they are) if the person is considerably older than you. If you sense that your interviewee does not want to answer a question, skip that question and move on to a different one.
- 1. Where were you born?
- 2. What do you remember of your early childhood?
- 3. Did you always live in one place, or did you move around?
- 4. Where did you grow up?
- 5. What were your elementary school, junior high school, high school, and college like?
- 6. Who was your best friend when you were younger? Do you still keep in contact with him/her?
- 7. What did you want to be when you grew up? Did you change your mind?
- 8. What person had the greatest influence on your life?
- 9. What famous person do you admire most?
- 10. If you could travel anywhere in the world, where would you go, and why?
- 11. What was the worst job you ever had? What was the best job you ever had?
- 12. What is your favorite animal and why?
- 13. What's the best book you have ever read?

- 14. What's the best movie you have ever seen?
- 15. Have you ever had to learn a new skill as an adult? What was it? Was it hard for you to learn?
- 16. Do you speak any foreign languages? What are they?
- 17. What is the nicest thing that someone has ever done for you?
- 18. What is the hardest thing that you ever had to do?
- 19. If you have a day that is completely free, how do you like to spend your day?
- 20. Do you prefer the beach or the mountains? Why?

Remember, these questions are just a guideline for you to use for your interview. The more information you find out about your friend the more interesting your report will be. Your report doesn't have to include all of the answers to the questions you ask. Pick the most interesting details that really show what the person you are interviewing is like.

It may be a good idea to give a small present to the person you interview to show your appreciation.
